





Matara city has many sites that stand as a testimony to the past of Sri Lanka. You must visit Matara at least ones in your life time to know Sri Lanka better. If you wish to visit Matara, include the following places to visit in Matara. The Star Fort, Dondra Head Lighthouse, The Weherahena Temple and The Dutch Reformed Church are some of them.

The Star Fort is constructed in the shape of a star. It was built by the Dutch to prevent attacks from external enemies. The Dondra Lighthouse is located at the Dondra Head on the Southern tip of the Sri Lankan island. It is the tallest lighthouse and the height is 160 feet. The Weherahena Temple is located on the eastern part of the town Matara. The temple contains an artificial cave which stands decorated with scenes from the life of Buddha. There is a gigantic Buddha statue towering over 25 meters in height. The Dutch Reformed Church is located within the Matara Fort in Matara and it is situated near the entrance to the Fort. It was built by the Dutch in 1706 and it is a smaller version of the church in Galle Fort. It is one of the oldest Protestant churches still in use in the country.



Enid Mary Blyton was an English Children's writer whose books have been among the world's best sellers since the 1930s. She was born on 11th August 1897 in East Dulwich, South London, United Kingdom. Her father's name was Thomas Carey Blyton and her mother was Theresa Mary. Enid Blyton was the oldest of the three children. Blyton attended St. Christopher's School in Beckenham, where she enjoyed physical activities and became school tennis champion and captain of lacrosse. Later, she married Hugh Alexander Pollock and gave birth to two girls, Gillian and Imogen. Blyton's books are still popular and have been translated into 90 languages. She wrote on a wide range of topics including education, nature, fantasy and mystery. She wrote many books. Her first book was "Child Whispers". It was a collection of poems. Malory Towers, The Famous Five, The Secret Seven and Noddy are her other books. Blyton's pen name was Mary Pollock. She was a novelist, poet, teacher and a short story writer. She died at the Greenways Nursing Home, North London on 28th November 1968.


